

How to draw a Shamrock

Did you ever pick a shamrock or clover? How many leaves does a shamrock have? Where were you when you picked the shamrock? Did you ever wonder how to draw a shamrock?

Estimated Time: 1/2 hour

Age Level: 5-12

Objective:

Children will learn how to draw a shamrock

Material List:

- 9 X 12 white drawing paper
- Pencils
- Erasers
- Big crayons
- Cardboard or oak tag

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1.) Cut a piece of oak tag or cardboard paper roughly 3 1/2" x 8", and draw your heart shape template on it. Cut out.
- 1.) Cut tip off and draw center dot on bottom
- 2.) Take a 9 x 12 sheet of drawing paper and fold it in half, then in half again. Open it and draw a cross where the fold lines are in the center.
- 3) Line up dot in the center of the cross and trace heart.
- 4) Trace heart on all 3 sides of the cross and erase all extra lines.
- 5) Draw lines around stem line.
- 6) Color in shamrock.



EXTRA:

Once complete, you can practice drawing the heart without the circle and triangle shapes, and then you can try it without the template and just use the cross for a reference. Eventually you will be drawing shamrocks without any help in no time.
